



KISSING GAMES

The General idea of all the kissing games are the same. Your guests will have to “do something” in order for you to kiss, if it’s done correctly then the bride and groom kiss. If it’s done incorrectly then your guests will have to pick a penalty from the “penalty box” and perform whatever the penalty is. The penalties are listed below. If you select any of these games, your DJ will explain this to your guests and call up a volunteer to demonstrate. The kissing game is explained just before grace is said and before we start to eat.



Kissing Dice- This dice has 6 sides, on two of the sides there are two huge lips and the other four sides are numbered 1-4. Your guest rolls the big dice, if it lands on the lips, the bride and groom kiss. If it lands on 1, 2, 3 or 4 you guest will pick from the penalty box and have to perform that action. Once they do this, then the bride and groom kiss. There are other variations of penalties instead of the “penalty box” such as whatever number it lands on, your guest has to kiss that many people, or do that many pushups etc.




Name That Tune- This game is just like it sounds. Your guest will go to the podium and say “DJ, I want to name that tune”, the DJ will play a 2-5 second clip of a song. If your guest guesses the song correctly then the bride and groom kiss, if they guess incorrectly they pick from the “penalty box”. The DJ will play a song that they think can be guessed easily unless a hard song is requested for someone. If there is not a lot of participation in this game then the DJ will add the “challenge factor” into the game. This is when a table can challenge another table or person can challenge another person. If a challenge is accepted and the song is guessed correctly, the person or table that initiated the challenge will pick from the penalty box. To simplify it, someone of table is always picking a penalty.

Wedding Wheel- The wheel is similar to a “crown & anchor” wheel. The wheel is divided into 8 sections and you pick any 8 of the 16 below pieces below to be put on the wheel. Your guests will come up and spin the wheel and whatever game piece the wheel lands on your guest will have to perform that action. Here are the 16 pieces that we have, remember, you pick only 8 of them to be put on the wheel.

1. Bride & Groom Kiss (freebie)
2. Bride & Groom Kiss (another freebie)
3. You kiss the Bride & Groom
4. Bride & Groom Trivia
5. Sing a song with love in it
6. Strike a pose
7. Do the Robot (to music)
8. Do the Macarena (to music)
9. Do the Bird dance (to music)
10. Do the Y.M.C.A (to music)
11. Do the Twist (to music)
12. Moonwalk back to your seat (to music)
13. Do the Hula Hoop (to music)
14. Bar Slave for your table
15. Bride & Groom Choice
16. Blank (you pick anything you want)



Operation- Yes, this is the board game and this is how it works. Your guests will come up to the game. They will select a body part that they will have to remove with making the game “buzz”. If they are successful in removing the body part, then the Bride & Groom kiss. If they aren’t successful, they will have to go kiss the body part of their date that they didn’t remove successfully”. For example, if your guests selects the “funny bone” and in the process of removing the funny bone the game “buzzes”, then your guest will have to kiss the funny bone of their date.



Bean Bag Toss- There are 11 holes in my game and you decide how many “kiss” pieces go on the game and the rest will be “penalties “ or actions that your guests have to do in order to have you guys kiss. The “penalties” are pretty much the same and the kissing dice and wedding wheel but we can add any of the ones that you think of. Your guests will come up and throw the bean bag onto the game piece and whatever it lands on your guests will have to do. This game is simple and straight forward.



Bride & Groom Trivia- This is a game where you will have to do a little bit of work. You will need to prepare about 20-30 Questions about yourselves such as where you met, where he proposed, favorite TV show, where you both work etc. Your guest will come up and either the DJ or the MC will ask your guest a trivia question about you guys. If your guest guesses the right answer then you kiss but if they guess wrong then they will pick from the “penalty box”. After they perform that action then the Bride & Groom will kiss.



Hula Hoop- This game is really easy and self explanatory. There will be hula hoops beside the podium or head table and your guests will have to hula in order for you guys to kiss.



Skipping Rope- This game is also self explanatory but not so easy. There will be skipping ropes beside the podium or head table and you guests will have to skip in order for you to kiss.



Copy Cat- Couples will come up to the Head Table and kiss, the Bride & Groom will have to copy exactly how the couple kisses, EVERYTHING! This is a lot of fun if you can get some creative people up there to kiss. Another variation of this game is that you put all of your guest names into a “hat” and when your guests clink the glasses you, the DJ or the MC will pull out a couples name. That couple will have to come to the head table and kiss, then you have to copy how they kiss. You also add your names in the “hat” as

well, usually once for about every 15-20 couples, that way a couple might be spared if your name is picked.

Here are the list of penalties that are in the “penalty box” but remember that we add more as we think of them so there may be more when your wedding comes around. That being said, if you think of a penalty for your wedding or want it added to the box, let us know and we will be happy to add it.
